The outcomes of this process were informed by all stakeholders: students, parents of students, CREA staff, local schools, community members, and CREA's Board of Directors and Advisory Council.

Six key strategic priorities were identified to strengthen and add more depth to programming in order to ensure CREA's primary Initiatives integrate well with each other, more children and youth have more consistent access to our literacy + learning programs, and multiple pathways to success exist for all participants.

Over the next three years, CREA is committed to continual investment in staff, infrastructure, and exceptional programming with ongoing input from all the communities we serve.

Intentionally Restructure the Youth Development Initiative

Integrate CREA programming for adolescents to holistically provide support for all youth, effectively quadrupling access for adolescents

Create Structures + Support

Create structures and processes to support the opportunity for more adolescents to engage in CREA programs from tutoring and electives to university scholarships



Expand Adolescent Involvement in Community Health

Deepen peer to peer learning by facilitating more opportunities for youth to learn to give talks around adolescent health in their communities

Respond to Community Needs by including English and Computer Skills Education

Implement English language learning and computer skills for increased opportunities for adolescents

Primary Goals

To create additional learning spaces and classrooms in support of all Initiatives

To improve technological infrastructure to ensure consistent access to learning

Additional Learning Spaces

Create 6 additional outdoor classrooms that address the overwhelming number of students who come to the CREA Library + Learning Center for daily programming

Stabilize CREA's Energy Sources

Install solar power with battery back-up to stabilize electricity and provide consistent literacy + learning programming while modeling sustainability



Reliable Internet Connectivity

Replace the current Internet tower to weather more frequent and powerful storms in the region and install additional access points to ensure that CREA's Internet access is consistent

> Investment in Technology Hardware + Software

Secure additional computers and tables as well as software to provide effective literacy, math, technology, and English language programming for all participants





STAFF + LOCAL TEACHER CAPACITY BUILDING



Primary Goal

To provide continued high quality professional development for CREA staff and local teachers in order to increase the capacity of educators in the region



Continue CREA's Partnership with TeachUNITED

Build the teaching and learning skills of CREA staff to equip them with high-impact strategies to ensure all students can reach their full potential.

Deepen Staff's Ability to Teach Literacy Skills

Build on CREA's literacy knowledge by continued training with literacy experts in intervention techniques to develop skills in teaching decoding and comprehension.



Deepen Staff's Ability to Teach Math Skills

Create opportunities for CREA staff to engage in professional development in fundamental mathematics methodologies

Create Opportunities for CREA Staff to Share their Knowledge

Facilitate foundational literacy and math training for local schoolteachers to further support students in the communities CREA serves
